Maths	<p><i>In addition to the school's maths scheme the children will focus on the following:-</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continue 2x; 5x; 10x; : practise at school and home• Fractions $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ – recognition and sharing amounts into $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$• Time:- o'clock; $\frac{1}{2}$ past; $\frac{1}{4}$ past; $\frac{1}{4}$ to in analogue and digital time• Money:- recognition to £1; computation and shopping up to £1; totals, change etc.• Directions and turning:- left, right (full turn; $\frac{1}{2}$ turn; $\frac{1}{4}$ turn)• Shape: 3D, 2D properties and symmetry• Key Stage One teacher assessment (SATs) is ongoing
English	<p><i>In addition to the School English Scheme the children will focus on the following:-</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Stories from around the world linked to Geography theme• Comprehension answering in simple sentences• Poems and stories on the theme of materials/change• Children will be working towards joining letters more fluently and developing their handwriting style.• Children need to be constantly corrected about formation and position of letters and pencil hold even at home.• Weekly spelling tests and results sent home every Friday in spelling books. Children should practise spellings at home.• Children will be given reading practice to be done at home for 10 – 15 minutes each night. (See Helpful Hints sheet)• Key Stage One teacher assessment (SATs) is ongoing
