Maths	<p><i>In addition to the school's maths scheme the children will focus on the following:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Formation of numbers and continuing work on number recognition• Graphs: eye colour; boys/girls• Ordering heights• sorting exercises: loud/soft; rough/smooth etc.• Descriptive length language: fat/thin etc. <p><i>Areas of experience conducive to mathematical activities</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recognition of coins 1p, 2p, 5p• Days of Week
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children have a folder which contains marker, word book, sound book and reading book. This provides a concrete link between home and school i.e. the learning to read process.• Children must read regularly at home (<i>10-15 mins each night</i>)• Children will read to the teacher on a regular basis at school. (<i>Please sign and date reading book record, when you hear your child</i>).
Phonic Work	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We continue our introduction to spelling and learning to read using a phonic approach.• The sounds we intend to cover are: o, f, p, k, e, l, v, w, j, b, u, q particular attention as always being focused on their correct formation.
Handwriting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We continue to concentrate on correct letter formation with the flicks.• Children will start to copy their dictated writing from a piece of paper into their books.
