Maths	<p><i>In addition to the school's maths scheme and numeracy hour document the children will focus on the following:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Formation of numbers; number recognition (Ten Town introduced)• Sorting, counting, classifying, making sets• Counting, reciting number names
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children have a folder which contains a marker, word book, sound book and reading book. This provides a concrete link between home and school i.e. the learning to read process. These will be given home when I feel the pupil is ready.• Children need regular reading practice for 10 - 15 minutes each night (see Helpful Hints Sheet).• Children will read to the teacher on a regular basis at school. (Please sign and date marker when you hear your child).
Phonic Work	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This is an introduction to spelling and assists in the learning of reading. Sounds will be introduced in the following order: c; a; d; h; m; t;• Particular attention being paid to letter formation.
Handwriting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Left-handed and right-handed sheets to show correct formation of letters are attached.• In Reception we concentrate on correct formation of letters with flicks.• Children need to be constantly corrected about <u>formation and position of letters and pencil hold</u> - even at home
Curriculum Focus	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Traditional Stories• Nursery Rhymes; Number Rhymes; <p>Stories - (<i>The Enormous Turnip, Chicken Licken, Ginger Bread Boy, Little Red Hen, Goldilocks and the Three Bears, Billy Goats Gruff.</i>)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Colour and Christmas
